## **Bearing With The Teeth Whitening Cost**

Sarcasm aside, the economic downfall of many industries these days led to a hefty increase in the price of goods and commodities including labor costs and services. These things are applicable to almost all entities including that of the dental sector, which will be the main topic of this article: teeth whitening cost (to be more specific).

Teeth whitening procedures are so popular these days that a lot of small companies, even those not having dentists are sprouting here and there to cater to the huge profitable market. Procedures like gel whitening, laser bleaching, strips, tray fittings and using home kits are just among the most common ones available. Many argue that these cosmetic procedures are useless and are just used for vanity purposes. Still, many disagree and bank on the fact that having a good sparkly set of teeth boosts their self confidence and thus, making them feel more at ease in their daily dealings.

Cosmetic dental procedures such as teeth whitening, cost more or less depending on the type of procedure opted for and where you are getting that kind of procedure. Let us then discuss the actual costs or prices of each. In the Philippines where labor is a bit cheaper, the home kits would still be the cheapest ones available amounting to about as low as Php400.00 or about \$10 to as high as about Php3000.00 or about \$70. Visits to dental clinics for actual teeth whitening procedures that include those mentioned above or a combination of them would range from about Php6,500 (approx.\$150) to Php15,000(approx.\$350). In other countries like the UK or the US, the teeth whitening cost is more expensive. Laser light applications would range from \$1000 to \$2000 while BriteSmile and Gel Tray applications would both amount to around \$470 to \$1000 respectively. Deep bleaching can be a bit cheaper costing only about \$800 per session (and usually it takes only 1 session). Of course strips still would rank the cheapest among all these but more or less, these are the common ranges of tooth whitening costs. With combination of these and the rise and fall of dental supplies, the price may also vary accordingly.

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your teeth.
